Yet there has been no substantive study of Fianna Fáil's language, ideology, and policy on Northern Ireland since the outbreak of the Troubles. This fascinating and important new book provides an examination of Fianna Fáil's record on Northern Ireland since 1968. It outlines the party's response to the Troubles and its guiding principles in the search for the solution. Catherine O'Donnell argues that the relationship between Fianna Fáil and Sinn Féin is central to understanding Fianna Fáil's role in the peace process, which began with the Fianna Fáil-Sinn Féin talks in 1988. She investigates the implications of the peace process and the Good Friday Agreement for Fianna Fáil's ideology and policy on Northern Ireland and highlights the continued centrality of the relationship between Fianna Fáil and Sinn Féin to the peace process and politics in the Republic of Ireland. As Sinn Féin make further electoral gains in the Republic of Ireland, this book will be essential reading for anyone wishing to understand how Republicanism is a contested electoral resource within southern politics.
